- ※ For groups 1, 2, and 3, applicants whose native language is English should contact to GSIS Education Affairs Section (Kyomu-gakari) directly.
- ※ Only the scores you took in the past 2 years from the first day of the entrance examination are valid.
- ※ The scores from group examination (TOEFL-ITP or TOEIC-IP) and TOEFL-CBT are not acceptable.
- ※ If you do not submit the score sheet when you apply, your English language score will be rated as zero.
- ※ The DI code of GSIS is "2149" for asking ETS to send us the score sheet directly.
- ※ It is known that it takes approximately 4 weeks or more to be shipped after the test (For both TOEFL/TOEIC). Please confirm with the organization about the date you receive the score sheet before you take the test.

Please have enough time for the preparation and be in time.
