Please make sure to register with the **Safety Confirmation System**.

**Tohoku University has introduced a system to confirm the safety of students and teachers in preparation for a disaster. This system makes it possible to easily report the status of your safety to the university from your mobile phone in the event of a disaster!**



This system will send safety confirmation and emergency notifications **in the event of a disaster or emergency** to the e-mail address registered in the Student Affairs Information System so that you can receive them on your mobile phone or PC.



If you receive a notification by e-mail, access the system via the URL provided in the message. Simply select your responses to report your safety status.
