

ASAHI GLASS SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION
Foreign Student Scholarship Provisions for Fiscal Year 2016

1. Estimated number of awardees: 12 (3 students from each country in GSIS)
2. Scholarship payment
 - (1) Payment sum: ¥100,000 monthly
 - (2) Duration: For the regular school years of the attending school
(For a maximum of 2 years for master's and 3 years for doctor's course)
 - (3) Payment method: Through a bank transfer on a set date of each month
3. Qualification
 - (1) Those with Thai or Indonesian ~~or Chinese~~ or Korean citizenship, who have come to Japan for study or research purposes, and are attending a master's program (first year students) or a doctoral program (first or second year students, as of April 2016) at one of the eligible universities.
 - (2) Those who have not been awarded scholarships from the Governments of Thailand, Indonesia, China, Korea, Japan, or from any other foundations.
 - (3) Those with good conduct, high scholastic ability, and who are in good health
 - (4) Those who have difficulty in paying the tuition
4. How to apply
 - (1) Documents
 - A. Scholarship application (prescribed form enclosed) * For your information, the applicant's academic advisor can become the Guarantor written on page 5.
 - B. Research proposal (prescribed form enclosed)
 - C. Both (a) and (b) are required.
 - (a) One letter of recommendation from either the principal or dean.
 - (b) One letter of recommendation from either the head of department or the applicant's academic advisor (It is desirable to mention the possibilities of development and usefulness of the research.)
 - D. Certificate of student registration (or entrance)
 - E. Certificate of academic record (of the last degree. Undergraduate transcript for a master's applicant. Masters transcript for a doctoral applicant.) Please enter the percentage of grade A or 優 on the margin (including better grade than those)
 - F. Income proof of parents and another person who is supporting the household, if applicable.
(as attachment of the application sheet page 4.)
 - Provide 2015 income proof issued by the authority or employer.
 - Image printing or copies are acceptable.
 - Provide also that of spouse if the applicant is married.
 - The proof for having no income is also required.
 - Applicants are asked to translate main items of the proof into Japanese or English.

G. Copy of passport (the page of photograph)

(Request) Please make documents of A and B using computers except in difficult cases.

To get the file, please send us an email from each university's office to info-scholarship@agc.com. Asahi Glass Scholarship Foundation will send back the file. If using a computer is difficult, the documents can be prepared by hand. In addition, please clip all the documents by applicant for submission. We would like to ask not to use staples and not to print on both sides of paper.

(2)Application deadline: March 8, 2016 GSIS

No direct application or inquiry from individuals will be accepted.

The Foundation will accept applications from only the offices of eligible universities.

5. Screening

(1)Screening will be held based on submitted documents and interviews. Please recommend one student for each country, at most 4 students.

(2)Interviews are scheduled from April 8 to 13 except Saturday and Sunday. The schedules and other detailed information will be sent by April 6 to the e-mail address in the submitted scholarship application to only intended students.

(3)Notification to scholarship recipients is sent to each university by the end of May.

6. Miscellaneous

(1)Successful applicants will be awarded scholarships retroactively to April 2016.

(2)Scholarship will be provided through Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ, Ltd. Successful applicants will be asked to open the bank account if they don't have one.

(3)There is no obligation to pay back the scholarship received, nor is there any obligation to join the company upon graduation, or to make donations.

7. Personal Information Management of the Foundation

- The foundation will manage the collected personal information properly in line with Personal Information Protection Policy of the Asahi Glass Scholarship Foundation.
- The Foundation will use collected personal Information for scholarship provision, advice for students or other purposes of the foundation within a necessary scope.
- When necessary for its operations, collected personal Information may be provided for any third party. In such cases, the foundation will conclude a contract with the third party or take any other measures that obligates the third party to be responsible for the management of the Personal Information to be provided, thereby preventing its leakage to any other party or other misuse.

Frequently-asked questions

Q1. May students of fall enrollment apply?

A. Yes, they can. However, students of fall enrollment in 2016 can not apply. Since scholarship payment period is until the formal expected graduation, they will receive less amount of scholarship compared to students of spring enrollment.

Q2. Can more than one student be recommended because internal selection for each country is very difficult?

A. Please recommend one student for one country basically. If it is too difficult, please rank them internally.

Q3. Is it ok to use other format? To use graphic style to show research results?

A. It is no problem to use other format as long as you make it in accordance with our original questions and make it A4 size. You can add pages but please make the content specific and simple. Graphs or images can be used for explanation. Documents should be prepared using computers, but handwriting is acceptable if it is difficult.

Q4. Applications may be late for the deadline.

A. Because the screening will be started soon after the deadline, we can't include late applications. Please make sure to meet the deadline.

Q5. What is the guarantor for?

A. We might make inquiries to the guarantor when Asahi Glass Scholarship Foundation has trouble contacting to the student. We request the person is in Japan. It is not for financial guarantee.
