Curriculum

Korean Language Course

Korean language instruction is provided by Sogang University's Korean Language Education Center, renowned for its brand of innovative task-based language instruction that trains learners to communicate in Korean efficiently. The program employs a learner-centered curriculum that requires students to combine thinking and performing in Korean to develop communicative competence. Students will take a placement test before the start of the program and will be placed according to their levels.
