I am writing from the Berlin Institute of Technology (TU Berlin) to draw your attention to our TU Berlin Summer University, a high-quality summer program for international students in Berlin, Germany. As one of the largest technical Universities in Germany, with 33,000 students enrolled in 115 degree programs, we are dedicated to expanding our international outreach. We ran the first program of the TU Berlin Summer University in the summer of 2015, welcoming international students from 24 different countries onto seven diverse courses. Following this success, 2016 will see more than 15 courses offered in specialized disciplines, such as Satellite Design, 3D-Printing, Energy Efficiency and Power of Social Media.

The TU Berlin has strong academic partners worldwide, and the TU Berlin Summer University reaches out to both existing and potential university collaborators worldwide, to enable students to enroll for 2016, as well as to form partnerships for the TU Berlin Summer University in the future.

This summer, the **TU Berlin Summer University opens it's doors on July 11th and ends on August 19th**. Students may choose from two, three, four and six-week courses, and may combine any two within the allotted timeframe. Parallel to the six weeks of academic courses, a cultural program of historical visits, team-building

workshops and socials, is included within the program fee. Accommodation options close to the university campus are also available and students receive a public transportation ticket when they arrive. Please find the complete course list at the end of this letter.

Online registration is open now on the below mentioned Summer University homepage. There is an **Early Bird discount rate available until February 29th, 2016**. Students can earn up to 8 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) credits. The courses are aimed at students with a study level from second year undergraduate, right up to a master's or even postgraduate level. Please refer to our website www.summer-university.tu-berlin.de to find detailed information about the course prerequisites.

The TU Berlin Summer University is very proud to announce that it will be offering scholarships to its participants, after successfully applying for funding from the DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service). A total of €75,000 was awarded - a profound achievement which will enable international participants to join the program as scholars in summer 2016. More information will be available on the TU Berlin Summer University website in the second half of December.
