Learn about the exciting new technology of 3D printing, and gain practical experience by printing your own creations.

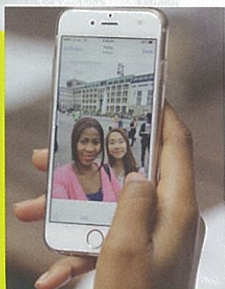
