The primary objective of the Global Intern Program is to carry out research and provide training related to science and technology.

IPA has worked to organize Global Intern Program once a year, offering students from various countries the opportunity to participate in six weeks training course at GIST. This year, we are seeking highly qualified intern students for the Summer 2015.

The Global Intern Program Summer 2015 is designed to provide knowledge and skills related to science and technology in the areas of Information and Communications, Materials Science and Engineering, Mechatronics, Environmental Science and Engineering, Life Sciences, Nanobio Materials and Engineering, Physics and Photon Science, and Medical System Engineering.

Details:

- Participants of the Program will be assigned to a department laboratory and receive their research training and coursework under the supervision of the professor in charge of the laboratory.
