
* The accommodation fee of US\$250 will be deducted from the program fee if the student does not apply for accommodation.

All-inclusive Program Fee

The program fee includes tuition, lecture materials, airport transportation service, orientation, accommodation, travel insurance (NTD 1 million for travel insurance and NTD100,000 for accidental medical insurance), cultural events, company visits, 1-day tour of Taipei and 4-day field trip. The fee does not include international transportation to Taipei. Students will need to make their own arrangements.

● Service Innovation


Define, analyze, and classify the innovation of service industry in Asia.
