

Guide to written examinations (English) submission of TOEFL®Test /TOEIC®Test score sheet as a part of the entrance examination to GSIS

The necessary application documentation is as follows. Please submit either one.

TOEFL®Test	Please upload your TOEFL® Test Taker Score Report to the application system [TAO]. In addition, please arrange for your online scores to be sent from ETS in the U.S. to our graduate school so that they arrive at least two days before the application deadline. GSIS's DI code: 2149
TOEIC®Test	(For those who took the test overseas) Please upload your Official Score Certificate to the application system [TAO]. Please also submit the original document by postal mail. (For those who took the test in Japan) Please upload your TOEIC Digital Official Score Certificate to the application system [TAO]. Please also enter the URL.

- ※ For group 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7, Applicants whose native language is English should directly contact the GSIS.
- ※ TOEFL ITP® Test or TOEIC® IP Test from 2 years before the entrance examination date to those for which results can be submitted by the application deadline are valid. Scores from group TOEFL ITP® Test and TOEIC® Institutional Program (IP) tests are not accepted.
- ※ One may submit scores of multiple tests provided they are of different types. If a score sheet is not submitted with your application (by deadline), your English language score will be rated as zero.

Applicants are advised to check examination dates and take examinations early, bearing in mind the time necessary for the university to receive the official score report by the deadline.
