- 4. Required qualifications and conditions. The ideal candidate:
- (a) hold a doctrate.
- (b) have outstanding international achievements and perspectives in one of specialized fields described in section 5.
- (c) have a strong desire for research and education in one of specialized fields described in section 5 and an enthusiasm for interdisciplinary research.
- (d) be able to give lectures and conduct business in Japanese, although candidates of any nationality are welcome to apply.
- (e) be able to cooperate with other faculty members in a leadership position in research, education, and administrative duties.
- 5. Specialized fields of responsibility:

This field involves mathematical or statistical approach to human issues related to information education and information literacy in the information society. Specifically, it is desirable to be able to empirically study how people perceive and read information in learning activities, internet use, and media reception (especially visual narratives such as comics and videos), mainly from the perspective of psychology. The candidate should be willing to conduct collaborative research with other fields related to information sciences, such as educational technology, media culture theory, and linguistics.

Subjects to be taught: Specialized courses in the Master's and Doctoral Programs of the Graduate School of Information Sciences, and Tohoku University General Education.
