- ※ For group 1, 2, 3 and 5, Applicants whose native language is English should contact directly to the GSIS.
- ※ TOEFL ITP® Test or TOEIC® IP Test from 2 years before the entrance examination date to those for which results can be submitted by the application deadline are valid. Scores from group TOEFL ITP® Test and TOEIC® Institutional Program (IP) tests are not accepted.
- ※ One may submit scores of multiple tests provided they are of different types. Where a score sheet is not submitted with your application (by deadline), your English language score will be rated as zero.
- ※ TOEFL® Official Score Report for mailing, the GSIS's DI code is 2149.
- ※ When submitting TOEFL®Test / TOEIC®Test official score report, please ensure that the ETS sends it to you / the GSIS by the time of application. This may take 4weeks or so.

Applicants are advised to check examination dates and take examinations early, bearing in mind the time necessary to send examination results to the university.
