- ※ The TOEFL ITP® Test and TOEIC® IP Test for group examination are not accepted.
- ※ You may submit scores from more than one exam of different types.
- ※ If you do not submit your score sheet by the last day of the application period, your English ability will be rated as zero.
- ※ When requesting your TOEFL® Institutional Score Report sent to us directly, the DI code is 2149.
- ※ If you have asked the organization to send your TOEFL® or TOEIC® score sheets directly to us, please check the information provided by the testing organization to confirm how many days it will take for them to arrive.

Please make sure you have enough time to complete the application process in time.

Some groups may handle it differently from the above due to the status of the public English tests in response to novel coronavirus (COVID-19) infection. Check the application guideline for the group and the admission category you wish to take before completing the application procedures.
